Detail:

The top 5 riders in competitions 402 and 407 (Thursday's and Friday's 1.40m) qualify. The remaining riders will qualify based on points from 402 and 407 to a maximum of 35 horses. Riders will receive points from their top placing in each competition only. Points will be assigned as follows: 1st – 50 pts, 2nd – 48 pts, 3rd – 47 pts, 4th – 46 pts, and so on to 50th place. Riders can only qualify if they complete the first round of the competitions (eliminations, retirements or disqualifications do not qualify). **ONLY the top 10 riders return for the 2nd round.**

Detail:

Those riders not already qualified through the FEI rules must qualify from Competitions 403 & 408 (Thursday and Friday's 1.45m). The top 5 riders from each competition qualify. The remaining placings will be determined based on points, to a maximum of 35. Riders will receive points for their top placing in each competition only. Points will be assigned as follows: 1st – 50 pts, 2nd – 48 pts, 3rd – 47 pts, 4th – 46 pts, and so on to 50th place. Riders can only qualify if they complete the first round of the competitions (eliminations, retirements or disqualifications do not qualify).

All athletes, including those automatically qualified must complete, with their Grand Prix horse, the initial round of at least one 2* competition prior to the Grand Prix.

Those riders not already qualified through the FEI rules must qualify throughout the week. The Top 5 riders from competitions 404 (Thursday's 1.50m), 405 (Thursday's 1.55m) and 410 (Friday's 1.55m) will qualify. The remaining placings will be determined based on points from competitiond 405 and 410, to a maximum of 50. Riders will receive points for their top placing in each competition only. Points will be assigned as follows: 1st – 50 pts, 2nd – 48 pts, 3rd – 47 pts, 4th – 46 pts, and so on to 50th place. Riders can only qualify if they complete the first round of the competitions (eliminations, retirements or disqualifications do not qualify).

All athletes, including those automatically qualified must complete, with their Grand Prix horse, the initial round of at least one 5* competition prior to the Grand Prix.
