If full payment is not received on time, your horse will be assessed a \$500 penalty. Cheques returned N.S.F. and/or declined Credit Cards will be subject to a \$150 fee. A \$1000 no-show fee per week (plus any extra stalls and pre-ordered feed) will be charged for horses entered in the FEI entry system that do not compete, or are withdrawn after the definite date.
