I further understand that all Spruce Meadows Ltd. tournaments will be governed by the laws of Alberta and Canada, and any suspicious activities will be reported to the proper authorities. In the event that the above listed rider participates in an Equestrian Canada or FEI sanctioned competition where protective headgear is required, he/she/they will wear properly fitted and fastened approved headgear at all times while riding or driving at the event location. It is understood that juniors not meeting this requirement will not be allowed to compete at these competitions (A802.6). The person responsible agrees to the release of any information on the entry form to Equestrian Canada and the FEI.

The competitor and his/her representatives hereby consent to receive any medical care and treatment that may be deemed advisable in the event the competitor or his/her representative sustains an injury or illness while participating in the tournament. The competitor authorizes and voluntarily consents to the release and disclosure of personal health information by a physician, hospital, emergency medical technical or Spruce Meadows for the purposes of diagnosing or providing treatment, for payment of any medical care or treatment, or for coordination of care. The competitor understands and agrees that (s)he is solely responsible for and will assume liability for all costs for medical care and treatment and will indemnify and hold harmless Spruce Meadows from all liability for such costs.

The competitor understands that Spruce Meadows will be gathering photographic and video images and recordings during this event, which images and recordings may include the competitor or representatives.
